



## Woodinville High School PTSA 2019-20 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Woodinville High School PTSA is pleased to offer scholarships to three graduating seniors in the class of 2020. The goal of these scholarships is to acknowledge academic achievements and contribution to the school/community through work or volunteer activities. One of the three scholarships will be awarded based primarily on financial need.

**AMOUNT:** Three \$1,500 scholarships will be awarded. The scholarship must be used for tuition fees at an accredited two or four-year college or university, or an accredited vocational/technical school during the year following graduation.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Applicant must be a graduating senior from Woodinville High School.

**EVALUATION:** Applications will be evaluated using the following criteria: leadership, school and community involvement, academic performance, financial need, letter of recommendation, and essay. Consideration will be given to effort in completion of application and overall presentation. Judging is performed by a committee of PTSA members. Names will be removed from applications prior to scoring. The final tallies will be compiled and the top three candidates will be awarded scholarships. The recipients will be notified by May 1st.
